Chick life cycle exploration set

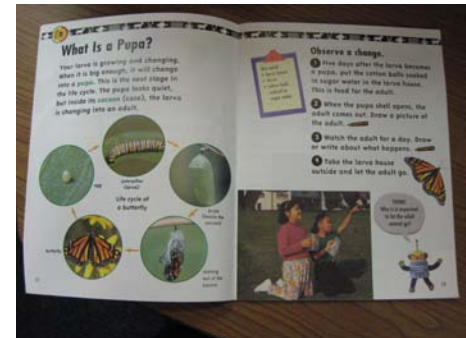

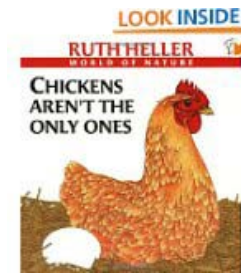
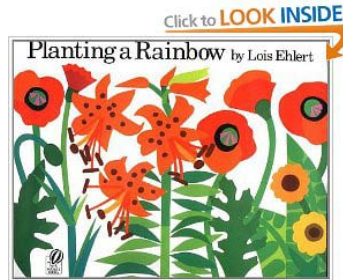
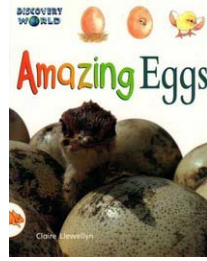
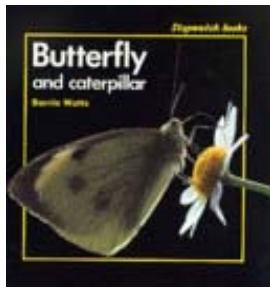
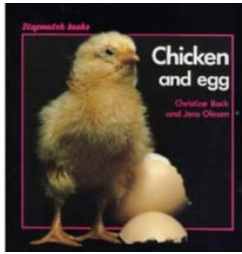


Life cycles: how living things grow and change: K-Gr. 3
