

## SCHOOL FEES 2017/2018

### Elementary Schools:

1. School Supplies

Most elementary schools within the district offer students supplies for the school year at the following recovery cost.

Kindergarten to Gr 1	up to \$40.00
Gr 2-3	up to \$45.00
Intermediate Gr 4-7	up to \$50.00

Beairsto does not provide school supplies. Parents contact the school to obtain a school supply list in the first week of September.

2. Student Agenda Planners - maximum \$12.00 (cost recovery)

3. Cultural Activity Fee (Performances) \$5.00
