

School District No.22 Academies and Specialized Programs enhance the curriculum. Students are motivated to strengthen their skills and improve their abilities in programs that are offered both by the district and in partnership with community organizations. Participating students will receive specialized instruction and learning opportunities that increase student engagement and success.



## ACADEMIES/SPECIALIZED PROGRAMS

**Who may participate?** All students in Grade 8 - 12 in School District #22 are eligible to apply. Maximum number of students is eight. Golf Academy will be in the 2nd semester of the 2019-2020 school year. Commencing in February 2020, students will be enrolled for half days or 2 blocks.

**What is the cost?** International students cost: \$3000 all inclusive. Cost: \$2,250 per student (golf instruction, range pass, Golf Academy clothing package, supervision, administration, assessment, assignment of grades and academic course credit). Vernon Golf and Country Club membership and Fitness West memberships are not included in the costs. Students have to apply for and pay for these memberships.

**How to apply?** Application forms and Code of Conduct forms are on-line under "Academies" on the SD#22 website. Completed application forms can be handed in to the Pro Shop at the Vernon Golf and Country Club, your home school or School District Board Office, Attention: Tom Williamson.

A \$250 deposit must accompany all applications. Cheque to be made out to "High School Golf Academy". The remaining fee of \$2000 must also accompany the application with a post dated cheque of September 30, 2019.

Applications will be reviewed by the Golf Academy Director and the Pro Golf Staff at the VGCC. Selection of qualified applications will be on date and time of completed application received. Deposit will be refunded, if not selected.

## GOLF ACADEMY SEMESTER STRUCTURE

February 2020 - students will be delivering introductory golf instruction to elementary students in SD #22 using Golf Canada's program. During this time Golf Academy students will be working on a golf specific strength and conditioning program at Fitness West till the end of April.

March to June 2020 - In the "afternoons" Golf Academy students will have tee times and will play the golf course using the knowledge base they have and are developing. Wednesday will be a continuation of the fitness program until the end of April. In May and June, Wednesdays will be vLearn days to work on the online academic golf courses.

In the "mornings" Golf Academy students will receive golf instructions Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.
