Summer Camp Program

Vernon School District's Summer Camp is structured to give students access to all our schools and community have to offer. Students will take part in an academic program that combines 50% English language instruction to further develop the student's English language abilities and 50% activities-based language practice allowing students to use their English in real life situations. Vernon School District Short Term Programs focus on cultural and social integration for the students, allowing them to fully experience the Canadian way of life.

The Program Includes Highlights

- Airport pick up and welcome reception
- Homestay program for students (double placement)
- Three meals and two snacks per day (students bring bagged lunch to camp)

School and In-Class Programming

Your students will be placed at one of Vernon School District's quality schools. Half of the time will be spent in dedicated English Language Development classes designed to increase the student's comfort with the English language. Taught by qualified English language teachers certified by the British Columbia government, these courses will focus on the specific needs of your students to allow them to continue to develop their English language skills.

The other half of the time will be spent engaging in the greater Okanagan community through cultural, social, and sporting activities. A program designed specifically to experience the best of the Canadian life and continue to improve their English language abilities in a low-stress environment.

Activities

The Greater Vernon Area offers a number of excellent outdoor and cultural opportunities for students to experience Canadian culture. Homestay

Vernon School District offers an extensive professionally-supervised homestay program to care for your students. All students will be matched to a Canadian family who will take charge of your child and ensure they have a quality homestay experience. Homestays will provide all meals, suitable sleeping accommodations, access to home needs. Our families will include the students as a part of their families and show them what the Canadian lifestyle is like.

Homestay placements are double placements, meaning that students will be paired together and placed two to a family for the duration of their stay. Students will have separate beds and access to private space.

Program includes:

- Airport pick up and drop off
- 3 meals per day, plus suitable snacks
- Homestay accommodation with Canadian family
- English classes taught by certified BC Teachers
- Activities as scheduled during program
- Comprehensive medical insurance

Program does not include:

- Airfare
- Visa/immigration documents
- Spending money for souvenirs, etc
