

CrossRoads Expectations

Before registering at CrossRoads, students and parents/guardians should have read and understood the expectations listed below. Upon Registration, failure to meet expectations may lead to disciplinary action.

1. Students will have read and understood the [Alternate Programs](#) code of conduct.
2. In addition, students will be expected to adhere to the site specific practices and policies for CrossRoads Learning Centre.
 - a. Attendance
 - i. Students are expected to attend from 8:30 am to 3:00pm, Monday through Thursday.
 - ii. Students are expected to sign-in when arriving at school and sign-out upon leaving school.
 - iii. Students may take their breaks from
 1. 10:00 am to 10:15 am
 2. 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm
 3. 2:45 pm to 3:00 pm
 - iv. Students who will not be in attendance during the expected times will have the parent/guardian call the school.
 - v. Students who wish to leave the school while school is in session must first have the parent/guardian call the school.
 - vi. Students are expected to attend a minimum of 20 hours per week. Shortfalls must be made up during lunch hours.
 - b. Conduct while in attendance or registered at CrossRoads
 1. Be respectful of the school environment.
 2. Work on course work at a pace of 10% course completion per week.
 3. Participate in school directed activities.
 4. Students may not participate at the “family of schools” without staff permission.
 - c. Computer Use
 - i. Computers will be used for school work only – other appropriate use may be permitted on an individual basis.
 - ii. Students wishing to listen to music while working
 1. Must use their own device.
 2. Must use earphones/headphones.
 - d. All guests must wait at reception for a staff member to address their inquiries.
 - e. Parent/Acknowledgment - Please sign and thereby acknowledge that you have read and understood and will adhere to the policies and meet the expectations listed above.
