

General Expectations at Hillview Elementary

General:

Students will help to show pride at Hillview School by keeping the building and grounds free of litter.
Students will not chew gum at school.
Hats and hoodies are removed at the door.

Hallways

Students will walk in the hallways.
Students will move quietly when in the hall.
Students will use the door closest to their classroom (as assigned by their teacher) to enter and exit the school.
Students remove their outdoor footwear on the mats as they enter the school. Clean indoor shoes with non-marking soles are to be kept at school.

Before School

Students arriving in the morning are to be in the back playground area.
Students remain outside until the bell rings. They may leave their backpacks outside of their assigned door.

Recess

All students are expected to go outside for recess unless they have teacher's direct permission for that recess to remain inside.
Washrooms should be used at the beginning or end of breaks.
Snacks are eaten in the classroom.

Lunch Hour

Students will eat their lunches in their classroom in an appropriate manner.
At the 12:20 bell, students who have finished their lunch will leave their classroom and begin their chosen lunch time activity.
All students should be finished their lunch by 12:30.

Busses

Students will wait for their bus in a safe manner, in the appropriate areas, and will follow the instructions of the Supervisors. The bus is an extension of the school and students must follow the directions of the bus driver and bus supervisor.

Use of Telephone by Students

Students must have a telephone pass to use the phone.
Use of the phone by students from 2:30 to 3:00 will be limited. All after school arrangements need to be done before the school day begins.
Students who are ill, must have an adult make arrangements for the student to leave the school.

The Playground Rules of Hillview School are:

1. Students will show respect for others. Bullying, intimidation, fighting, racial slurs, cruel teasing, aggressive play, and overt defiance are not acceptable behaviors at Hillview School. "Fill buckets"
2. Students will not play roughly on the playground. Tackling and wrestling games are not permitted. "Hands off"
3. Students will follow instructions given by staff.
4. Students will play in the designated playground areas. Map outlining playing field areas is reviewed with students in classrooms.
5. Students will enter the school immediately when the bell rings, using the door designated for their classroom entry.
6. Rocks, sticks, snow and ice will not be used as dangerous objects.
"At Hillview School, the snow stays on the ground."
7. Students will share the equipment and make efforts to have play that is inclusive of everyone.
8. During school hours, students will not leave the school or the playground for any reason without direct permission or a note signed by their parent/guardian and/or their teacher and the principal.
9. If a ball should go out of the school grounds, permission from a supervisor/teacher is needed before going to retrieve it (over the fence, across the road etc.)
10. Students will leave unsafe objects at home. (knives, hard balls, hockey sticks etc.)

Cell Phones, Cameras and Electronics

Students are to leave all electronics at home. If families want their children to have cell phones for to and from school, they need to be given to a teacher before school.

Cameras are to be used for learning activities only. Students do not have permission to post online or share any photos of students or staff of School District 22.

The school will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Polite, Respectful Responses

Students are expected to follow the directions of staff members the first time and respond in a polite manner. They are reminded to use respectful tone of voice, body language, choice of words and actions

Bicycles:

Bicycles must be walked when on the school grounds.

Bicycles should be locked when at school and students will not play on or near the bicycle racks. It is the law that all bicycle riders wear a helmet.

Skateboards, Roller blades, Scooters

Skateboards, roller blades, and scooters are not allowed at school except at designated times.
