Drama Film and Television 12

A group of instructional programs that describe the methods and techniques used to produce and broadcast programs on radio and television. Film and Television 12 traces the development of video as a media. It traces the history of filmmaking from visual storytelling, early cinema and the studios, right up to today's independent and consumer video. It was developed to provide Grade 12 students in BC with a broad understanding of key films in the history of motion pictures, the concepts and techniques central to this history, and opportunities for practical production experience. The course begins with the early development of motion pictures at the turn of the century and leads learners towards an understanding of contemporary cinema, including blockbuster movies. Completion of Drama: Film and Television 12 (History of Film) satisfies the graduation requirements for Fine Arts.
