- Cost:** There is a \$100.00 registration deposit required. Students taking English courses will need to provide a \$50.00 textbook deposit. We accept cheques or cash only. These deposits will be fully refunded provided the student does not drop out prematurely and the textbook is returned in good condition.  
**Final deadline for registration and payment will be May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011.**
- Attendance:** **Daily attendance is required. There can be no exceptions as timelines are very short. If you can't commit to this requirement summer school is not for you.**
- Marks:** School marks will be available from the teacher upon course completion. Marks will also be forwarded to the home school once provincial exam results are received.
