

Online Summer School

2012 Facts Sheet

Registration: Online at: www.vlearn.ca April 16th until May 15th, 2012
Register early as registrations will be closed when capacity for each course is reached.

Note: Not all students are suitable candidates for taking courses online. The self-directed, capable and motivated student who is comfortable using computers is most likely to be successful in the online environment.

Dates: May 15th to July 31st, 2012. In order to participate in online courses during the summer session all students must become active in their courses prior to June 1st. Daily work on courses will be required to ensure they are completed prior to July 31st.

Times: Daily as required by the teacher and course completion demands. Online courses can be accessed from the vLearn.ca web servers by students 24/7 for the duration of the course.

Provincial Exams: Required attendance for e-exam writing for **BC First Nations 12** and **Social Studies 11** will be held on Wednesday, August 15th, 2012 from 9:00am-11:00am. Students must bring photo identification and arrive 15 minutes early.

Exam Location: W.L. Seaton Secondary, 2701-41st Avenue, Vernon BC.

Cost: **All online courses are free to school aged students.**
Deposits are required for the following courses: Socials 10 and 11 - \$80.00, BC First Nations 12 - \$30.00, Family Studies 12 - \$60.00. The deposits are to be paid prior to starting the course and are payable by cash or cheque ONLY. Students can pick up the textbooks at The Open Door Education Centre, 2901-29th Street, Vernon BC. If out of town students cannot obtain the textbooks from their local schools we will mail them and the cost will be the responsibility of the student. All deposits will be refunded when the texts have been returned in good condition.

Marks: Marks will be available from the teachers upon course completion. Marks will also be forwarded to the home school for submission to the Ministry of Education.
