Peanut/Fragrance Allergies:

Please avoid nuts and peanut products in your child's lunches. We have several students with severe peanut allergies. In addition, please refrain



from wearing **strong fragrances** while on school premises as we have staff and students with fragrance allergies.

Medications/Medical Alert Plans:

Those students requiring medical plans must have them updated yearly.

If your **child requires a plan**, please contact the office as soon as possible. It is imperative that we have all current medical information and medicine updated. Just a reminder that students requiring the administration of medication, must have a parent/guardian fill out the "Request for Medication at School" form and have it signed by your child's physician.

Symptomatic at School

Everyone is expected to stay at home if they are not well. Even mild symptoms will require students and staff to remain at home and follow guidelines for return.



Parents are expected to do a health check for their child every day and keep them home if they are ill. If a child or staff member becomes ill while at school, individuals will be placed in our medical room.

Parent/caregiver will be contacted to pick up an ill student immediately.

Staff with symptoms will leave the school immediately and be replaced by non-enrolling staff or administration.

Masks

All staff and students in Grades K-12 have the **choice** to wear a non-medical mask.

All students, staff, TTOCs, specialist staff, music, library, Education Assistants, counsellors, administrators and support workers, will be supported and treated with respect recognizing varying personal comfort levels.
