

A message from the Superintendent of Schools – School District 22 Vernon

September 2, 2021

Dear members of the School District 22 community,

It is my great pleasure to join all of you at School District 22, on the traditional and unceded territory of the syilx people. We know many of you are busy preparing for an exciting year ahead. Most important to all of us at School District 22, is the health & safety of students and staff, followed by wonderful opportunities to learn. Please know your child is at the heart of every decision we make. It has been a difficult summer for many staff and students, not only with the pandemic, but also wildfires, excessive heat, smoke, evacuations, and wondering about shelter, transportation, food acquisition and food sustainability. We hope that the return to school will bring some consistency, support, and peace.

Safe Return to School:

On Tuesday, August 24th, the Ministry of Education announced Provincial COVID-19 Communicable
Disease Guidelines for K-12 Settings. As per last year, the COVID situation will remain fluid, and we will adjust as needed. A reminder that we take our pandemic response direction from the Director of Public Health, Dr. Bonnie Henry, and under her guidance, Interior Health for regional matters, and the Ministry of Education. Student Transportation:

On Tuesday, September 7, buses will pick up all students for the regular time start time and deliver students home 3 hours earlier than normal. We are working hard with Okanagan Indian Band members and families, and all our Westside families that have been evacuated, to ensure we support those approved for transportation getting to school. Kindly contact transportation at 250-549-9281 for assistance. As we become aware of your relocation sites (ie: Silver Star, local hotels, other communities, etc.), we will work to help ensure your children get to school. We ask everyone to be patient the first few days as we sort out pick-up locations for those relocated and get everyone used to a few new routes. We thank you all in advance.

A reminder that <u>all riders from Kindergarten to Grade 12</u> need to register <u>annually</u>. To register your student, please refer to the link above.

If you are driving your child to school, don't forget that you must stop when you see bus lights flashing – no matter which direction you are driving. Kindly ensure all children have cleared the area prior to proceeding and watch those school zone speed limits. We want everyone to be safe.

Start-up:

All schools begin on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 at regular start times. Please note that the first day of classes will be an early dismissal day. Dismissal times for all schools will be 3 hours earlier than usual. Ensure you check your school website for start and pick up times.
