The Superintendent shall establish and publish fair and transparent procedures for the placement of students in an educational program.

The Superintendent shall:

- prioritize the placement of elementary school students living in-district in their feeder secondary school.
- prioritize placing children living in-district at the school their sibling attends.
- only adjust catchment areas with Board approval, by motion.
- consider, unless the parent chooses otherwise, a student and their pre-kindergarten siblings residing in an area impacted by a catchment boundary change and attending their legacy catchment school at the time of change as residing in the catchment of that school for as long as the child continues to attend that school.
- after considering specific inclusion needs and the ability of an educational program or school to accommodate that need, then decide priority between two or more children having the same priority:
 - for programs of choice, by lottery; and
 - for all other educational programs, by time of application.
