

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

- 1. In order to participate in an extra-curricular activity, students must be enrolled in the school where they intend to participate. A home-school or vLearn student may participate in the school catchment where they reside. There may be exceptional circumstances that can be reviewed on a case by case basis.
- 2. Subject to any regulations established by BC School Sports, a student may participate in another SD22 school's extra-curricular activity provided that:
 - 2.1. the activity is not provided at the school in which the student is registered or there are reasons that the student cannot or should not participate with the school the student is registered;
 - 2.2. both school Principals agree; and,
 - 2.3. the receiving school is able to accommodate the incoming student without displacing a student who wishes to participate in that particular extra-curricular activity.
- 3. The Principal *may* withdraw a student from extra-curricular participation. This will be done in careful consideration on a case-by-case basis.
- 4. All decisions about participation are at the discretion of the Principal or Superintendent.
