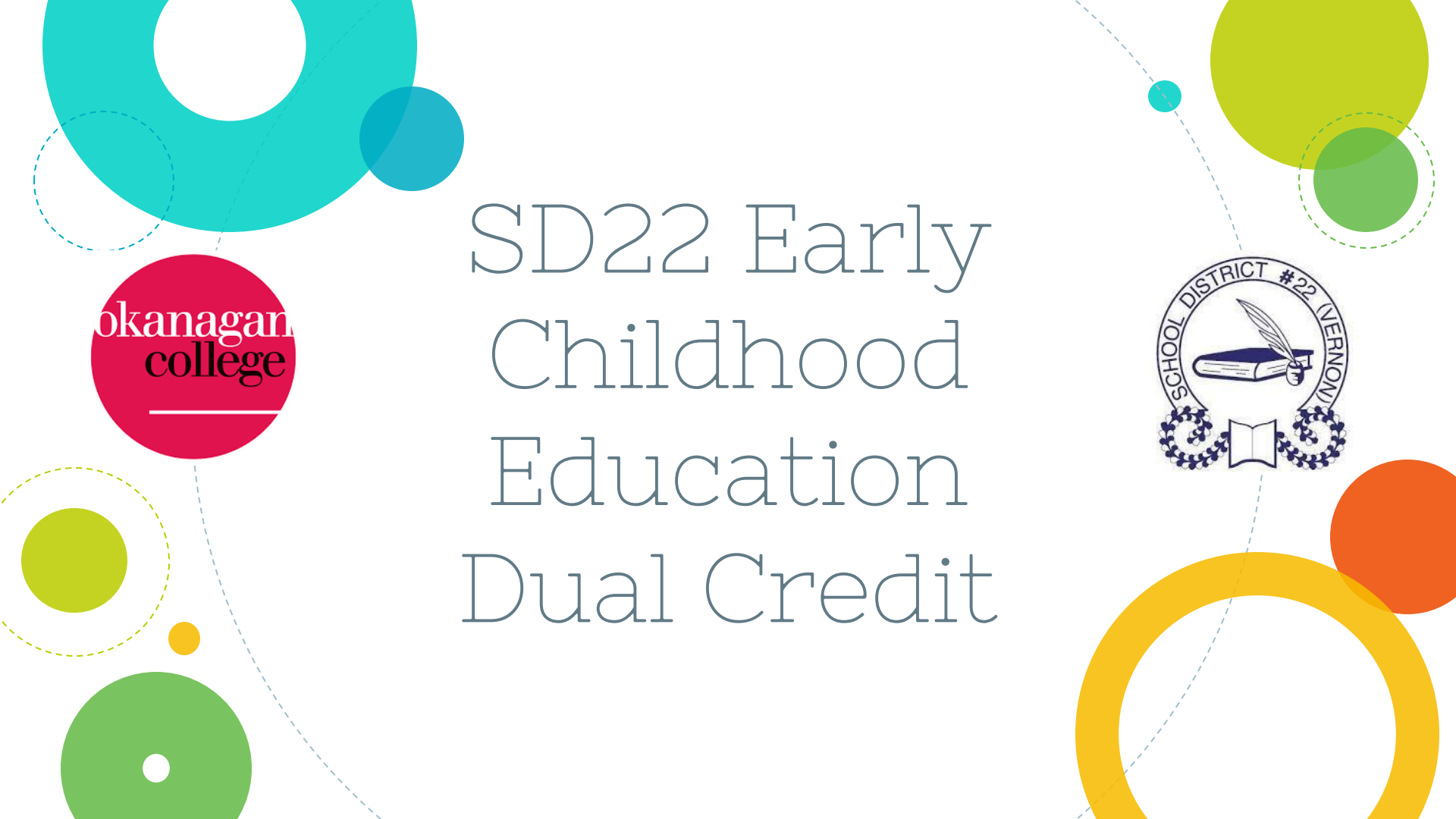
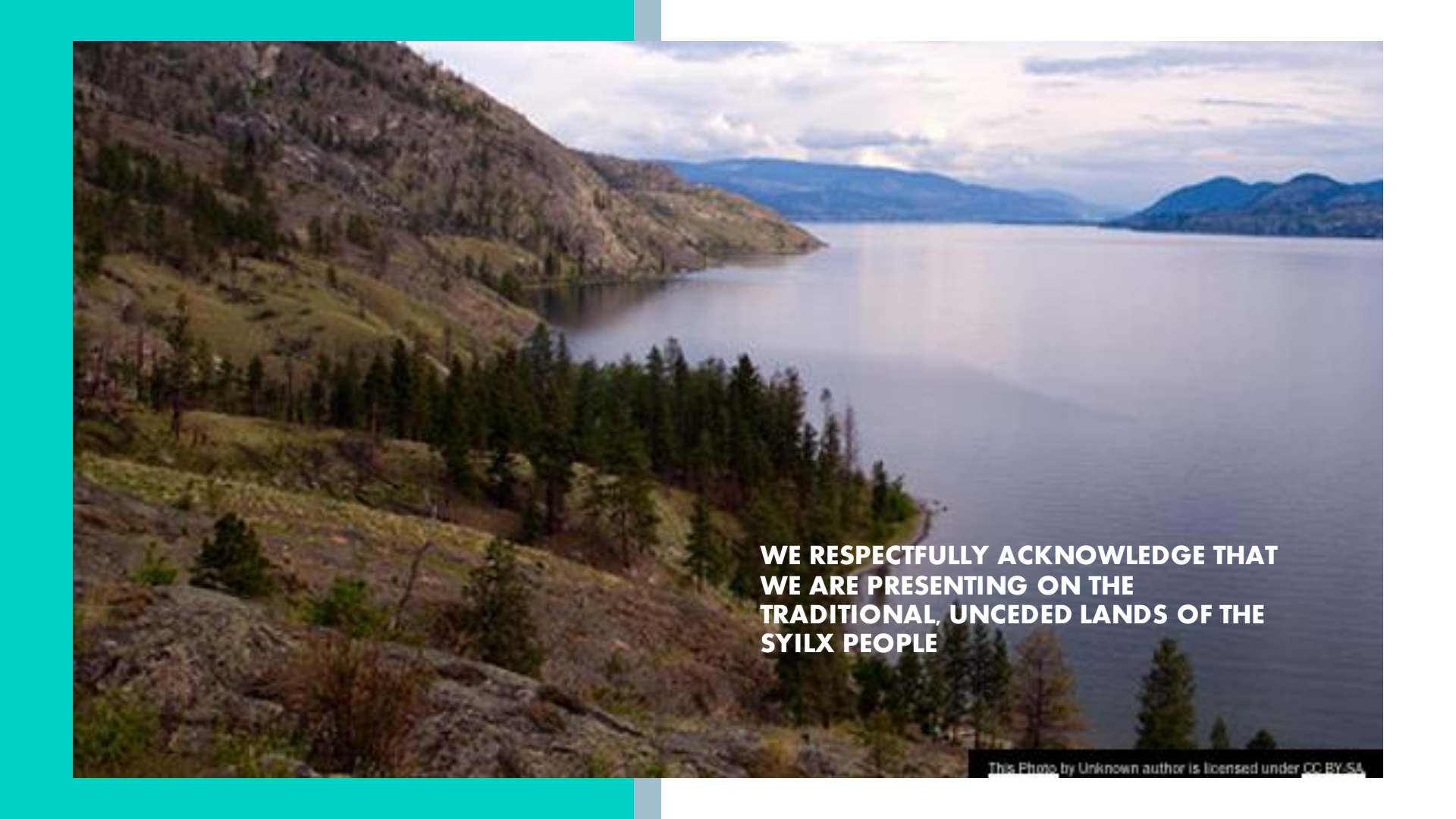

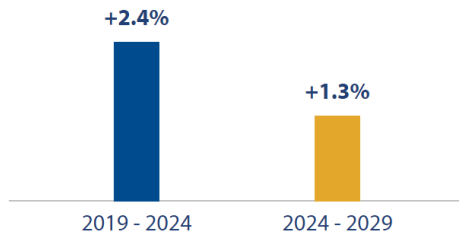

Provincial Outlook

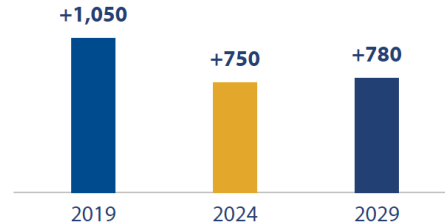
Forecasted average employment growth rate

OPTION 1

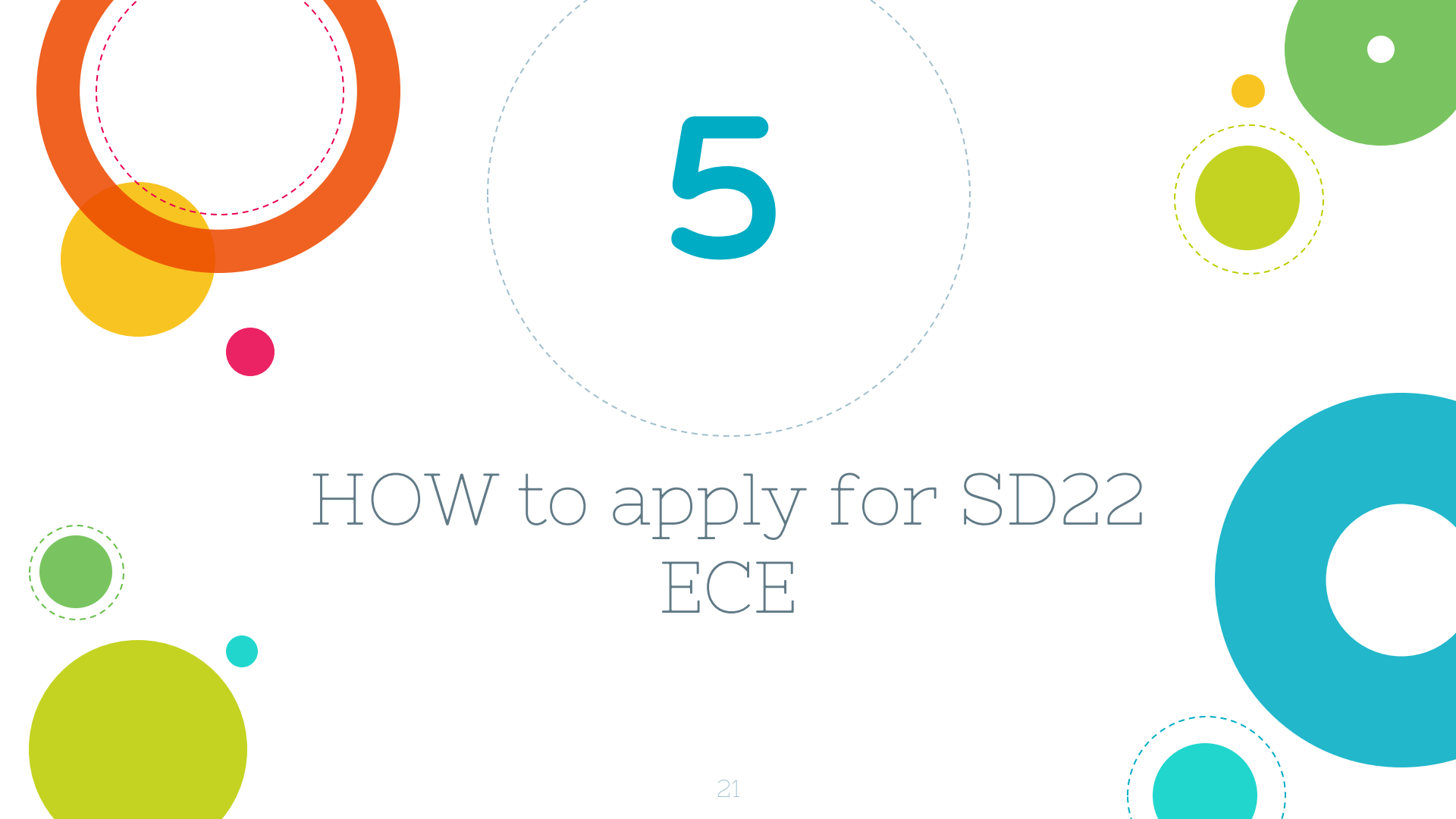
Students qualify to apply to the [BC Ministry of Children and Family Development](#) to receive an *Early Childhood Education Assistant* Certificate.

Tuition NOT paid for by SD22.

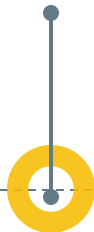
