#### SPEECH-LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION SERVICES

Speech-Language and Communication Services Caseload Priority Guidelines

Caseload priority decisions are based on three factors:

## 1. Severity of communication impairment

- 1.1 Severe Communication Impairment
  - Nonspeaking
  - Diagnosed severe language learning delay or disorder
  - Generally unintelligible; speech characterized by multiple phonemes in error, or by presence of multiple phonological error patterns that are not developmental in nature
  - Diagnosed severe fluency disorder
  - Diagnosed severe voice disorder
  - Possible presence of other factors: auditory processing, phonological awareness, oral motor or structural factors; relevant Ministry designation

### 1.2 Moderate Communication Impairment

- Diagnosed moderate language learning delay or disorder
- Speech intelligibity is poor to fair, characterized by multiple phonemes in error or by presence of some phonological error patterns that are not developmental in nature
- Diagnosed moderate fluency disorder
- Diagnosed moderate voice disorder
- Possible presence of other factors: auditory processing, phonological awareness, oral motor or structural factors; relevant Ministry designation

#### 1.3 Mild Communication Impairment

- Diagnosed mild language learning delay or disorder
- Speech intelligibility is good, with few or a single phoneme error that is not developmental in nature
- Diagnosed mild or maintenance fluency disorder
- Diagnosed mild or maintenance voice disorder
