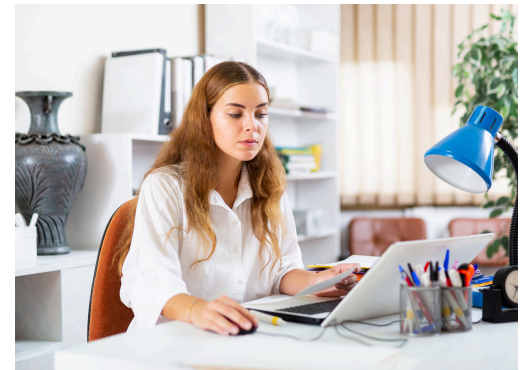

Dual Credit Certificate students are enrolled in post-secondary programs during high school and receive both high school and post-secondary credits. Students attend a post-secondary institution (times and dates depend on program).

Planning starts ideally at least a year in advance for these programs. It is best to start planning in Grade 10 or at the beginning of Grade 11, to ensure that prerequisites are arranged, because of competitive and limited seat availability.

School District #22 will sponsor the (1st year) tuition. You will be expected to pay all ancillary fees, as well as, any costs for student materials and textbooks. Please check with your Career Coordinator regarding program costs as some expenses may be covered by SD22.
