

HAIRSTYLIST PROGRAM

SCHOOL DISTRICT 83 AND PLEASANT VALLEY SECONDARY SCHOOL IN ARMSTRONG WILL OFFER THE 14^{TH} HAIRSTYLIST COHORT IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE $\overline{114}$ (INDUSTRY TRAINING AUTHORITY).

- ➤ This unique program features 10 months (2 semesters) of in-class & hands-on training; usually February to January 9:00am-3:25pm. This will be taught by a Red Seal Certified Hairstylist, who is also a Certified Teacher.
- ➤ Students will receive 36 Grade 12 Elective Credits upon satisfactory completion of the program (minimum 70% in all course work), and graduate at their home school. This Hairstylist Foundation Program consist of: Technical Training of 990 hours, Practicum of 300 Work-Based Training hours (300 hours must be gathered during school Work Experience placements, as well as hours from Summer work, and possible extra hours recorded by their instructor) and the ITA Standardized Written Exam (70% pass mark). Successful students will achieve Hairstylist Level 1. Students must also complete all Ministry of Education graduation requirements.
- ➤ There is no tuition cost, but students will be required to purchase a personal Hairstylist Kit for approximately \$1500.00 at the start of the program. This kit is then theirs to keep.
- > Students will attend this program during Grade 11 & 12 and adhere to strict attendance guidelines. Applicants will have to complete a comprehensive application form and have a successful interview.
- > Application deadline is April of the year before the February start date.
