

Dual Credit Academic Programs

School District #22 has partnered with post-secondary institutions to offer grade 12 students the opportunity to earn university-transfer credits and secondary school graduation credits at the same time. The Academic Dual Credit course will be a 9th course for senior students in their schedules. These courses will be available to high school students in the late afternoon/evenings or online and are transferable to universities and colleges.

The courses are sponsored by School District #22 and should be part of the Transition Plan towards the student's planned occupation/career.

The school district will sponsor the course tuition fee on behalf of the students, however, students will be responsible for textbooks/resources and all other ancillary fees, as required by the post-secondary institution.
