

2024 HPGA Golf Academy – Student Application

Program Start and End Date

- > January 31, 2024 through the June 27, 2024
- > Students will be registered for the HPGA program for 2 Blocks (A/B)

Instructors

- ➤ Golf instructional staff are working golf professionals at local courses
- ➤ Off-course fitness/P.E. programs are lead by certified fitness professionals
- > On-line instruction (vLearn) will be monitored by a high school level SD-22 teacher
- Personalized nutritional instruction provided by a PN1 certified professional

Core Program (included in your HPGA tuition fees)

- > Small group golf skill instruction with a certified golf Pro
- > Structured practice of learned skills to improve game transfer
- ➤ 18-hole play (Green fees included for all rounds played at VGCC and Hillview)
- ➤ Junior Golf Memberships at both VGCC <u>and</u> Hillview
- ➤ Hillview and VGCC Driving Range Pass
- ➤ Off-course Strength & Conditioning and Nutritional learning (via TASC coaches)
- > Titleist Performance Institute (TPI) Assessment by Certified TPI Professional
- > Self-directed project and study work to help learning effectiveness

School Credit

> Students receive Sport Development (Golf) & grade appropriate Physical Education (P.E.) credit via vLearn. Alternate course needs guidance and planning is done via Rod Peters

Transportation

➤ HPGA Student drop off and pick-ups must be arranged by the family. Non-family transportation plans must be reviewed with Academy Director for safety reasons.

Equipment

- > Students will be responsible to supply and maintain all their own golf equipment.
- > Proper club sizing and club selection will be part of the learning models (via course Pro's)

Student Eligibility

- ➤ This program is open to male or female Golfers attending Grades 8-12
- > Students must be able to free up or transition their AB Blocks in 2023. This program will accept a maximum of 8 golfers (2 groups of four)
- > Returning students receive priority on enrolment acceptance



Selection Criteria – Basic

- > Students must be in good standing with both their school and golf club or golf association.
- > Students without any prior golf experience as of Jan. 2024, will not be eligible in 2024.

Application Deadlines

- Applications are to be received <u>no later than May 15, 2023</u> with post dated deposit cheque (made out to TASC) or e-transfer c/o info@samtasc.ca
- > Program acceptance notification will be given on or before June 1, 2023.
- A priority wait list will be established if enrolment is full as of June 2, 2023.
- ➤ Deposit cheques will be cashed for <u>only</u> those accepted and confirmed into HPGA.
- ➤ **NB:** Deposit funds are 100% <u>non-refundable</u> once student acceptance is confirmed with parents and deposit cheque/payments have been finalized. (see your Financial Pledge)

Core Program Cost (HPGA Tuition)

- Cost of the 2024 Academy instruction program is \$2645.00 (+ 5% GST).
- ➤ Deposit cheque or e-transfer by June 1, 2022 of \$834.75 (\$795.00 + \$39.75 GST) must accompany <u>all</u> applications. Application <u>will not be date stamped</u> without full deposit.
