ELECTOR REGISTRATION (for voting day registration)

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of <u>OR</u> registered owner of real property in the jurisdiction for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **two pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written** consent from the majority of the property owners.
