Create Together

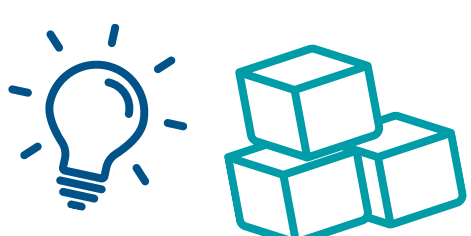
Creating builds problem-solving skills, imagination & personal expression, small & large muscle control and coordination, along with measurement, geometry & spatial awareness.
